**I. Extension to deadlines for ERC grant applications**

The European Commission has carefully assessed the challenges experienced by applicants for Horizon Europe grants affected by the situation in the Middle East. Taking into account these challenges, a decision has been taken to postpone the deadlines of the following grant competitions:

**ERC Starting Grant call** - from 24 October to **7 November**,

**ERC Synergy Grant call** - from 8 to **15 November**.

## II. MSCA Staff Exchanges (2023/24)

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Staff Exchanges promote innovative international, inter-sectoral and interdisciplinary collaboration in research and innovation through exchanging staff and sharing knowledge and ideas at all stages of the innovation chain.

The scheme fosters a shared culture of research and innovation that welcomes and rewards creativity and entrepreneurship and helps turn ideas into innovative products, services or processes. It is open to research, technical, administrative and managerial staff supporting R&I activities.

The MSCA are open to all domains of research and innovation, chosen freely by the applicants, and have a strong focus in interdisciplinary, international and intersectoral cooperation. Staff Exchanges support collaborative projects addressing this triple dimension spanning all research fields and provide specific opportunities to promote international cooperation between the academic and non-academic spheres.

Deadline: **24 February 2024**

## III. Physics for Future (P4F)

Physics for Future (P4F), MSCA COFUND programme, offers postdoctoral fellowships designed for excellent scientists who pursue their own research endeavours. The fellowships are supported by Marie Skłodowska-Curie Action Co-funding for regional, national, and international programmes (COFUND) under the European Union's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme, and coordinated by the Institute of Physics of the Czech Academy of Sciences.

The fellows are invited to submit bottom-up proposals in three broadly defined areas, namely Materials for Society, Matter under Extreme Conditions, and Emerging tools.

## IV. Conference on Microscopy Technology Dissemination

This conference will explore the challenges, solutions, and opportunities in microscopy dissemination. In doing so, it will bring together developers of easy-to-disseminate hardware, software, and imaging probes, as well as representatives from global imaging organizations, microscopy initiatives, funders, industry partners, and open-access imaging centers. Joined by end-users of microscopy technologies from international and domestic under-served scientific communities, presentations and discussions will focus on how to integrate common goals into unified strategies to bring imaging technologies to a broader range of communities.

There are no registration fees and Janelia provides accommodations and meals for all participants at no cost. Travel scholarships are available to those in need. Janelia encourages applications from individuals with diverse backgrounds.

## V. CELSA research fund: collaborative research projects

The 'CELSA Research Fund' will fund collaborative research projects between researchers of at least two CELSA partners, of which one must be KU Leuven, with the purpose of leveraging their efforts towards future Horizon Europe

applications (or to its successor or any other competitive European fund). An open call for proposals will be launched once a year for approvals, during two years, 2023-2024.

It is important to note that any scientific discipline can be qualified for funding by the CELSA Research Fund. Moreover, the funding can be used freely by the researchers involved, as long as the activities concern research, strengthen the collaboration within the CELSA network, and can lead to a high-quality application for any of the European competitive funds as mentioned.
