This event will focus on the narrative CV format and its potential effects on the evaluation procedures."

The event will start with an information session for potential applicants given by an ERC Executive Agency (ERCEA) representative. Next, Sean Sapcariu from the Luxembourg National Research Fund will introduce narrative CVs and describe their goals and potential effectiveness in the ERC StG applications. Last, the testimonial from YAE activities chair Serim Ilday on how she utilised a narrative CV in her successful ERC StG application will follow. The event will end with a Q&A session where attendees are encouraged to ask questions to the speakers and László Lovász, the academic director of the AE Budapest Knowledge Hub and member of the ERC Scientific Council.
