A Lendület Program keretében az MTA pályázati felhívást tesz közzé 2024-ben induló kutatócsoportok létrehozására. A Lendület Program célja a hazai fiatal kutatóbázis erősítése nemzetközi szinten is kimagasló teljesítményű kutatók és kiemelkedő fiatal tehetségek külföldről való hazahívásával, illetve itthon tartásával, és ezzel egyidejűleg a fiatal kutatók önállósodási törekvéseinek támogatása. A Lendület Program a kiválóság és a mobilitás együttes támogatására irányul, ennek megfelelően célja, hogy a befogadó kutatóhelyeken áttörő eredményeket ígéző kutatásokat végző kutatócsoportok számára biztosítson forrást.

A pályázatokat angol nyelven kell benyújtani a Lendület elektronikus pályázati rendszeren keresztül. Bölcsészeti- és társadalomtudományi pályázatok esetében indokolt esetben csak magyar nyelvű pályázat is benyújtható. A pályázati anyagok feltöltésének határideje **2024. február 12. 16:00**.

III. Science Europe High Level Conference on Science Communication

The High Level Conference on Science Communication is co-organised by the Research Foundation Flanders (FWO), Fund for Scientific Research (F.R.S.-FNRS), and Science Europe under the auspices of the Belgian Presidency of the European Union (January–June 2024), and will take place in a **hybrid format** between **12-13 March 2024**.

In recent years, researchers have become increasingly involved in public communication programmes; the COVID-19 pandemic and other global challenges have accelerated this trend. Despite this, misinformation and ‘fake news’ about important social issues – such as artificial intelligence, big data, food security, energy, and climate change – continue to spread through social and new media. This has led to growing international recognition that science communication is an essential aspect of research culture.

The conference will bring together European policy makers and stakeholders to highlight the importance of open, ethical science communication in research processes. It will also raise awareness of the need to address science communication more formally in research programmes.

- **EARTO Recommendations regarding the Evaluation & Pre-contractual Negotiations of Lump-sums EU Funded RD&I Projects**

EARTO members are very active participants in the EU RD&I Frameworks Programmes (FPs), especially in complex and large collaborative applied RD&I projects. In this context, EARTO Feedback on EARTO Members' Experiences with Lump-Sums Projects within Horizon Europe addressed wider issues related to lump-sums funding within Horizon Europe. With the recent announcements and discussions pointing to the possible extension of the use of this funding principle, EARTO members wish to alert the EU Institutions on worrying trends and signals regarding the evaluation and pre-contractual negotiations of lump-sums EU-funded RD&I projects. Indeed, with many newly selected projects using the lump-sums funding scheme under Horizon Europe, EARTO members have now proper feedback on their granting process and the issues that are rising.
