I. UnILiON Brokerage event on Cluster 5

There is a call for participation to the UnILiON Brokerage Event under the Climate, Energy and Mobility Calls on Cluster 5 Calls, that will take place online on Monday, 15 April. This event is organised by Brussels liaison offices from the UnILiON network. UnILiON is an informal network of around 54 Brussels-based liaison offices that represent over 160 universities across Europe, as well as in UK, Japan, and Norway.

The aim of the event is to build a platform for everyone, bring participants together to share their ideas, knowledge, and expertise and to find suitable partners for future consortia under the specific Horizon Europe calls in Cluster 5, with a particular focus on Destinations 2 and 6. Researchers, businesses, and other organisations are invited to pitch their project ideas or activities, related to the specific Horizon Europe Cluster 5 calls.

II. Lump Sum Funding in Horizon Europe: How does it work? How to write a proposal?

Horizon Europe uses lump sum funding to reduce administration and financial errors. Lump sums make the programme simpler by removing the need to report actual costs. This means easier access to the programme, especially for small

organisations and newcomers, who often lack the experience and capacity to cope with the complex rules for actual costs. In the upcoming session, participants will get acquainted with lump sum proposal writing techniques, and, by a panel discussion with invited guests, they will hear about first-hand practical experiences.

III. Personnel Unit Cost – New cost method in Horizon Europe

Horizon Europe allows beneficiaries to use personnel unit costs to provide a simpler and less error-prone way to declare costs for their staff in projects. One single daily rate for personnel is agreed upfront with the beneficiary. It applies to all their staff working in a project. This means there are no more errors in the daily rates, and beneficiaries will know from the start how much they will get paid per day worked. Reporting will become easier because it is limited to the number of days worked. Possible audits will be simpler, too. Using personnel unit costs is entirely optional.

This webinar is to share detailed information on personnel unit costs which is a new optional cost method to report personnel costs in a Horizon Europe project. During this session, participants will learn about the advantages of using personnel unit costs, how to calculate their daily rate, and the process to request it for their organisation.

V. Bridging the Scientific Gap: A Call for Global Support in Enabling Remote Access to Lab Equipment for African Scientists

This initiative started with the International Union of Crystallography (IUCr) and the French National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS), when a laboratory in the University of Lorraine in France gave access to a Single Crystal X-ray Diffractometer, which is a rare equipment in Africa. The initiative shows success and since there is a clear eagerness from African Scientists to gain access to more scientific techniques, UNESCO is hoping to expand this type of opportunity to more scientists in Africa while providing access to other sophisticated equipment such as advanced microscopes.

The initiative seeks, among others, to provide African scientists with remote access to essential laboratory equipment, and to promote knowledge exchange and collaboration between African scientists and their global counterparts.

Participating entities, such as governments, scientific institutions and industry leaders, can contribute by providing remote access to their laboratory equipment, through a shared arrangement, without affecting the productivity of the laboratories or its scientists.
