**I. Europe 2035 - konferencia Bécsben**

## V. SCOSTEP Visiting Scholar (SVS) Program

The SVS program is a capacity building activity of the Scientific Committee on Solar-Terrestrial Physics (SCOSTEP) with the aim of providing training to graduate students in well-established solar terrestrial physics institutes, for periods of one to three months. The training will help the awardees advance in their career in solar-terrestrial physics using the skills they learned during the training.

The program is open to applicants from all countries but with an emphasis on applicants from developing countries and is limited to master's and PhD students with the requirement that the recipient has not received a PhD at the time of application to the program. Interested candidates should contact one of the SVS program hosts; develop a project and work out the details of the visit. Once the applicant and host agree on a visit, the applicant needs to prepare an application package.

SCOSTEP will provide the airfare, while the host institute will provide living expenses. Please note that the 2025 SVS awardees will have until 30 June 2026, to complete their training program.
