I. Közoktatás-fejlesztési Kutatási Pályázat – 2025

Az MTA nyílt jellegű pályázatot hirdet olyan, 4 éven át (2025. szeptember 1. – 2029. augusztus 31.) történő kutatások támogatására, amelyeknek célja a nevelés és az oktatás fejlesztésének új tudományos eredményekkel való megalapozása, a pedagógiai gyakorlat feltárása, a tudásátadás és az értékközvetítés pedagógiai szemléletének és módszereinek megújítását célzó kutatások megvalósítása. A pályázatonként kiosztható maximális összeg: évi 30 millió Ft.

Pályázatot nyújthatnak be kutatócsoport vezetésére a Magyarországon működő alap-, illetve főtevékenységként vagy ahhoz kapcsolódóan kutatás-fejlesztési tevékenységet folytató intézmény, szervezeti egység vagy vállalkozás (a továbbiakban: kutatóhely) által legalább 6 órában foglalkoztatott oktatók vagy kutatók, akik a kutatási pályázatban bemutatott szakterületen jelentős szakmai eredményeket értek el. A pályázatot benyújtó személynek (a továbbiakban: kutatócsoport-vezető) a pályázat benyújtásának dátumát legalább 3 évvel megelőzően szerzett PhD-fokozattal kell rendelkeznie. Egy oktató, kutató egyszerre csak egy – jelen felhívás szerinti – kutatócsoportnak lehet a vezetője.

IV. Partner Webinar - Driving Transformation (High Sustainability Performance in Academia)

A university's environmental sustainability has long mattered to academic leaders. Increasingly, addressing sustainability has become a strategic goal, achieved by both the research and the teaching activities of the institution. In a recent Elsevier survey of 450 global academic leaders, 85% said high sustainability performance was a top priority for their institution, and nearly two-thirds said it had high transformational potential. However, only 54% reported making good progress.

Join as representatives from prominent European institutions discuss their sustainability initiatives, compare challenges faced, and identify successful strategies for fostering high sustainability performance within their organisations. This interactive session will also include a Q&A segment, allowing attendees to delve deeper into the topic and share their own experiences.

V. CFA: Azrieli International Visiting PhD Fellowship

The Azrieli International Visiting PhD Fellowship offers outstanding international PhD candidates the opportunity to conduct short-term research in Israel, fostering academic collaboration and strengthening global research ties. Fellows will work closely with leading Israeli researchers, gaining valuable experience in world-class academic institutions.

The fellowship is open to PhD candidates from all countries and academic disciplines who:

- Are enrolled at an accredited institution outside of Israel and have completed at least one year of their PhD studies at the time of application.
- Have not had prior academic experience in Israel.
- Have secured an academic host, who is a faculty member at one of the eligible Israeli institutions listed in the guidelines. Hosts may only sponsor one candidate per application cycle.

The fellowship is valued at ILS 12,000 per month and is offered for three to four months. The aim of the funding is to support accommodation, international airfare, living costs, fees, and health insurance. Candidates are permitted to start their fellowship at any point in November 2025, which is the beginning of the 2025–26 Israeli academic year.

VI. Generative AI and scientific development

Artificial intelligence (AI) is being employed in ever more scientific disciplines, enabling scientific breakthroughs and becoming an indispensable tool in the scientific process. To reap the full benefits of the development and uptake of AI in science, the EU needs to tackle important challenges, including concerns about its strategic autonomy, novel trends in scientific work, disparities of the labour market. For this reason, the European Commission (EC) is working on a European AI in Science Strategy, shaped together with the European scientific community. One of the EC's political priorities is to support the development of AI and other frontier technologies by pooling all European capacities and resources.

This event aims to lay the ground for a fruitful debate that looks into this topic from all angles, from the undeniable advantages to the risks associated with an extensive deployment of AI together with the ways to counter them. MEPs, together with the EC and researchers, will discuss the opportunities and challenges of the use of AI in science.

VII. ICGEB CRP Grants programme

The ICGEB CRP Grants programme was established in 1988 and aims to stimulate collaborative research in Member States and with the ICGEB Component laboratories, promote training of young scientists, and facilitate the creation of appropriate research facilities. The programme supports research projects in basic science, human healthcare, industrial and agricultural biotechnology and bioenergy. A call for applications is launched yearly.

Grants are awarded to contribute to the implementation of outstanding scientific research projects. An important element of successful applications is the feasibility of the proposed project within the designated timeframe (maximum 36 months). The maximum annual contribution from ICGEB is Euro 25,000. Funds can only be used to cover expenditures directly relevant to the project. This may include purchasing consumable items, scientific literature and basic standard laboratory equipment. Travel and training costs can also be covered.

Salaries of the Principal Investigators and infrastructural support (e.g., normal administrative and overhead expenses of the Institution, maintenance and rental of capital equipment, building, etc.) are not admissible and cannot be funded.

Applicants for research grant proposals (identified as “CRPs”) should hold positions at Universities or Research Institutes in any of the ICGEB Member States.
