## II. Call for new members of the Global Young Academy

The Global Young Academy (GYA) is a global organisation that places a high value on its diversity. Organisers encourage applications from all qualified candidates. All applicants receive consideration and will not be discriminated against with regard to race, colour, ethnicity, religion, creed, sex, marital status, ancestry, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, physical or mental disabilities, or other factors. We aim to avoid any single institution being overrepresented in our membership.

Moreover, organisers encourage women and applicants from different minority groups, and from diverse disciplines including the natural, physical and social sciences as well as the arts and humanities and people working in government, industry, and non-governmental sectors to apply.

Applications are sought from young, independent scholars who combine the highest level of research excellence with a demonstrated passion for delivering impact. The call is open to all scholars working in any research-based discipline, including the natural, physical and social sciences, as well as the arts and humanities. Applicants working in government, industry, and non-governmental sectors are also welcome.

Applications should be completed personally by the candidate and must be accompanied by a letter of support. Completing the application takes a minimum of 30 minutes. The online application form as well as the support documents need to be written in English.

## III. 2025 WFEO GREE Women In Engineering Award

As the peak international body for engineers, the World Federation of Engineering Organizations is proud to promote diversity, inclusion, and gender equality in engineering. During its 50th Anniversary celebration at UNESCO headquarters in Paris in March 2018, WFEO was proud to announce, with its sponsor GREE Electric Appliances, a new Award to bring recognition and visibility to outstanding women engineers. The Award recognises women engineers who have shown professional excellence and impact in their work, and are role models and leaders in their field.

The WFEO GREE Women in Engineering Award is awarded every year. Nominations are invited for outstanding women engineers who have made a significant contribution to engineering. Nominations can be proposed by an institution such as a university, engineering institution or association, corporate entity or another organisation. Nominations need to be approved by the President, Chief Executive, head of department in a university or equivalent institution.

Nominations and support letters from members organisations or associates of WFEO will be highly regarded. Self-nominations are not accepted. Any woman with a degree in engineering, currently active in engineering and with records of activities in one or several professional fields related to engineering: industry, consultancy, entrepreneurship, academia, public sector, NGOs.

The Prize consists of a medal, a certificate, and a cash prize of \$1,000 (USD). The Prize 2025 Laureate will be notified in Fall 2025 and will be presented during WFEO's General Assembly meetings session and the Global Engineering Conference held in Shanghai, China, on 13-17 October 2025.

#### IV. The Kavli Prize – Call for nomination

The vision for The Kavli Prize comes from Fred Kavli, a Norwegian-American entrepreneur and philanthropist, who turned his lifelong fascination with science into a lasting legacy for recognizing scientific breakthroughs and for supporting basic research.

Since the first awards in 2008, The Kavli Prize has recognized innovative scientific research – from the discovery of CRISPR-Cas9 to the detection of gravitational waves – transforming our understanding of the big, the small and the complex. The Kavli Prize Laureates are celebrated in Oslo, Norway, in a ceremony presided over by the Royal Family. The Kavli Prizes have so far honored 73 scientists from 14 countries.

Every other year, The Kavli Prize invites the community to nominate scientists whose basic research has fundamentally transformed the fields of astrophysics, nanoscience and neuroscience. The prize consists of \$1 million awards in each of the three fields and is awarded directly to the Laureate(s).

The Kavli Prize recognizes and values that different perspectives enable breakthroughs, and we are committed to recognizing breakthrough science worldwide. We encourage nominators to be mindful of the full breadth of the scientific enterprise and be attuned to gender, race and ethnicity, geographical region, and institutional range.
