#### III. The 9th edition NTNU European Conference

In a rapidly changing world, with increasing pressure on the sustainable prosperity and competitiveness of Europe, the arrival of a new European Commission ushers in an evolved set of political guidelines for shaping the continued prosperity of the European Union's strength and unity in the years ahead. Community & democratic values, security, and resilience are key components in the new plan presented by President of the European Commission Ursula von der Leyen in 2024. Investment, efficient implementation, and impactful measures are needed to ensure the perpetuation of Europe's social model and market economy in a continually shifting geo-political and economic world.

In this 9th edition of the NTNU European Conference we focus our attention on the challenges and opportunities ahead. We explore how the evolution of the guidelines and priorities set out by the commission together with the potential of technology as a facilitating tool can shape the future for European civil society and competitiveness on the global stage. #### IV. ERC Grants: what to expect in 2026 calls

The ERC has introduced some novelties in the 2026 Work Programme. This info session is designed to help applicants understand how these changes will apply to the submission of applications and evaluation of proposals, ensuring they are well-prepared for the upcoming calls for the Starting, Consolidator and Advanced Grants.

Participants will receive practical guidance on the application process with a focus on:

- the new proposal structure,
- the updated rules for the extension of the eligibility period.
- the additional relocation funding,
- the new resubmission restrictions.



While the session is open to researchers based in EU Member States and Horizon Europe Associated Countries, the ERC encourages those in Widening countries to attend, in line with the efforts to increase success rates in countries hosting few ERC grantees.

#### VII. Lem Prize 2025

The Lem Prize has been established to commemorate the 100th birthday of the great Polish visionary and science fiction novelist, Stanisław Lem, awarded doctorate honoris causa of Wrocław Tech in 1981. The Prize is awarded annually to one young researcher whose creative work in science or engineering has potential for positive impact on the future of civilization increasingly filled with technology.

The Wrocław University of Science and Technology (Wroclaw Tech) has announced a new call for applications – edition 2025. Applications should be submitted by 30 September 2025 to lemprize@pwr.edu.pl.

Applications may be submitted by scientists who:

- is 40 or younger in 2025,
- is affiliated with an academic or research institution in a European Union member state, in an associated country participating in Horizon Europe, or in Switzerland,
- has made in the last 3 full calendar years (from 1 January 2022 until the submission date) a discovery or significant achievement in broadly understood fields of science and engineering.

The winner will receive a cash prize of PLN 100,000 (approximately EUR 23,000) and will be invited to Wrocław for the Lem Prize award ceremony which will be held in 2026. The winner will also be expected to give a lecture about her/his discovery or achievement.

#### VIII. Long Covid: Current Realities, Future Directions

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, an estimated 400 million people worldwide have been affected by post-COVID-19 condition (PCC), also known as Long Covid. According to the WHO, around 6 in every 100 people infected with COVID-19 develop Long Covid, a condition that typically begins within three months of the initial illness, lasts for at least two months, and is marked by debilitating symptoms ranging from mild to severe, sometimes leading to long-term disability.

This workshop builds on the outcomes of a previous EPRS event that examined the then-emerging understanding of Long Covid--its clinical profile, its impact on patients and society, and the urgent actions needed to address gaps in knowledge, raise awareness, and advance treatment development.

By bringing together MEPs, researchers, policymakers, healthcare professionals, communicators, and patient advocates, the workshop seeks to foster a coordinated, multidisciplinary debate on Long Covid. Its goal is to share insights, challenges, and innovations, while informing both citizens and specialized audiences about scientific progress, policy developments, and practical experiences. Ultimately, it aims to contribute developing effective and long-term strategies for addressing Long Covid across Europe.
