IV. Biomedical models hub for evidence-based decisions

Join us for a webinar hosted by the Joint Research Centre (JRC) focused on the Biomedical Models Hub (BimmoH), a comprehensive dataset of scientific articles utilising human biology-based models, such as organ-on-a-chip technologies, 3D cell cultures, and computational models, aimed at facilitating more human-relevant biomedical research.

During the webinar, we will explain how we used AI for the creation of the BimmoH dataset, providing transparency on the article selection process and our methodological approach, relying on robust machine learning techniques. You will also learn to streamline research efforts and support innovation through practical applications of BimmoH, such as identifying state-of-the-art models on specific research topics, conducting biotech market analysis, and performing funding gap analysis.

Developed under a European Parliament Pilot Project, the initiative supports the EU's Three Rs principle for promoting animal welfare and sustainable innovation.

VII. Call for Nominations for the 42nd (2026) International Prize for Biology

The International Prize for Biology was instituted in April of 1985 by the Committee on the International Prize for Biology. It aims to commemorate the sixty-year reign of Emperor Showa and his longtime devotion to biological research and also to offer tribute to His Majesty the Emperor Emeritus, who has strived over many years to advance the study taxonomy of gobioid fishes while contributing continuously to the developing of this Prize.

The Prize is awarded to one researcher who has made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of basic research in the field of "Biology of Symbiosis (interspecific interactions)". Please note that this prize is awarded in recognition of an individual's lifetime research achievements, and only one individual is eligible to receive the award. The award ceremony and a commemorative symposium are held each year, and the prize recipient is expected to attend both these events. A certificate, medal and a prize of ten million (10,000,000) yen is given to the recipient at the ceremony.
