I. Pályázat a MTA Bolyai János Kutatási Ösztöndíjának elnyerésére 2026-ban

A Bolyai János Kutatási Ösztöndíjat kiemelkedő kutatási-fejlesztési teljesítmény ösztönzésére és elismerésére az MTA elnöke által felkért és az MTA köztestületi keretei között működő Kuratórium nyilvános pályázati rendszerben ítéli oda. Az ösztöndíjra 45. életévüket még be nem töltött, tudományos fokozattal rendelkező, de MTA doktora címet még nem szerzett személyek pályázhatnak.

Az ösztöndíj célja, hogy kiemelkedő minőségű tudományos munka megírásának vagy azzal egyenértékű, kutatási témában létrehozott alkotás elkészítésének, valamint az MTA doktora cím elnyerésére irányuló felkészülésnek elősegítése. A pályázat valamennyi tudományterületen, illetőleg tudományágban benyújtható.

Az ösztöndíj határozott időre (3, 2 vagy 1 évre) szól, és legfeljebb két alkalommal nyerhető el. Aki korábban egy alkalommal már részesült Bolyai ösztöndíjban, az abban az esetben nyújthat be újabb pályázatot, ha az első ösztöndíjas ciklusának záró kutatási jelentése "kiemelkedő" vagy "jó" minősítésű volt.

A pályázatot elnyert kutatók 2026. szeptember 1-jétől, az MTA Bolyai János Kutatási Ösztöndíj Kuratóriumának kedvező döntése alapján részesülnek az ösztöndíjban, amely összeg a pályázat kihirdetésének napján 250.000 Ft. A pályázatok elbírálásának eredményéről a pályázók 2026. június 10-éig kapnak értesítést.

As one of the founding professors at Princeton's Institute for Advanced Study alongside Albert Einstein and Oswald Veblen, von Neumann left a profound legacy. In 1999, the Financial Times honoured him as "Person of the Century," a testament to his enduring influence.

By bringing together students, early-career researchers, and senior scholars across disciplines, the Neumann Series fosters interdisciplinary exchange and a vision of innovation grounded in responsibility, creativity, and human values - reflecting the belief that we are not at the end of creativity and thought, but at the threshold of a bold new era. This is

the dialogue we seek to start - a conversation about embracing technology without surrendering the ingenuity that defines humanity.
