II. Harmonising Diverse Ethics and Integrity Frameworks? Practitioners' Perspectives

New challenges, such as the rapid digitalisation of science, the spread of AI, increasing public distrust in science and scientists, and growing threats to academic freedom, call for a decisive and coherent response by the academic community – one that ensures the highest standards of ethics and integrity at all stages of academic research. How can this be achieved in the face of multiple, often non-compatible ethics and integrity codes and frameworks?

The European Research Area (ERA) action “*Developing a coherent and coordinated framework for a European approach to integrity and ethics in R&I in the face of emerging challenges*”, which is part of the 2025–2027 ERA Policy Agenda, aims to address these issues at the European level.

The presentations and interactive sessions during the 15th ERION in-person meeting on March 17 2026 in Brussels will offer an opportunity to discuss this topic, to reflect on the benefits and challenges of harmonisation, to examine successful attempts at harmonisation at European, national, and institutional levels, and to explore which initiatives might have the potential to solve the problems that we face in our day-to-day-practice.

Ethics and integrity officers, and all other practitioners involved in research support who are interested in how to facilitate ethical research collaboration and responsible science in environments shaped by multiple ethics codes and frameworks, as well as those who would like to work towards greater harmonization of ethical standards and practices in their institutions, countries, and European networks are welcome to participate.

III. ESMH Summer School 2026 – Call for young journalists and content creators

The European Science-Media Hub (ESMH) of the European Parliament is organising a Summer School for young journalists on 22-25 June 2026 in Brussels to address the opportunities and challenges of AI in science communication.

AI has changed how news is produced, distributed and consumed, raising concerns about the future of journalism. The 2026 ESMH Summer School will explore how AI is being used in newsrooms and how to harness its potential for science communication, while also addressing the limits of AI-powered tools and their ethical implications. Through four interactive and hands-on workshops in smaller groups, experienced (science) journalists and media trainers will share how best to cover AI and incorporate it into reporting and editing practices. They will also share tips and tricks to help

navigate the complexities of science communication, including how to tell engaging science stories and captivate audiences.

The four-day Summer School will also include thematic panel discussions with policymakers, researchers, journalists and communicators. Up to 50 journalists will be selected and invited to the ESMH Summer School in Brussels. The ESMH will provide financial support to the selected journalists participating in the 2026 Summer School to cover the costs of their travel within the EU and accommodation (subject to conditions and eligibility criteria).

V. Call for inputs from stakeholders for the United Nations Global Sustainable Development Report

This open call for stakeholder inputs is convened by the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs on behalf of the Independent Group of Scientists (IGS) appointed by the United Nations Secretary-General to draft the 2027 Global Sustainable Development Report (GSDR).

The 2027 GSDR will be the third in a series of quadrennial reports, aiming to strengthen the science-policy-society interface and serve as a robust, evidence-based tool to support policymakers in accelerating progress toward poverty eradication and sustainable development. As mandated by UN Member States, the 2027 GSDR will inform the follow-up and review of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly the SDG Summit in September 2027, providing scientific guidance on the state of sustainable development globally, addressing emerging challenges, and offering actionable recommendations for governments and other stakeholders to better understand and navigate the complex relationships among social, environmental and economic development objectives in the last three years of SDG implementation and beyond.

To support the 'assessment-of-assessments' nature of the GSDR, this open call is designed to:

- understand stakeholder expectations for the 2027 GSDR, including what characteristics would make the report most relevant and useful;

- gather examples of good practices and lessons learned in SDG implementation from practitioners working to strengthen science-policy-society interfaces at all levels, including what works at the local level and where the gaps are;
- identify additional peer-reviewed assessments to complement the IGS' own research.

Kindly note that the questionnaire will collect information about your region, country, stakeholder type, gender, profession and organization to provide context for your input. By submitting input, you will agree to share it with the Independent Group of Scientists and to make your input (name and contact details not included) public.
