IV. Nominations for the 2027 Tyler Prize for Environmental Achievement are now open

The Tyler Prize is the world's most prestigious annual environmental prize. Often referred to as the "green Nobel Prize", it was the first prize of its kind to be awarded in the field of environmental science. The prize recognizes individuals and organizations that have made outstanding contributions to understanding and safeguarding our planet, as well as advancing solutions to critical environmental challenges. Laureates work across diverse fields within environmental

science and leadership including conservation, public policy and economics on issues including health, air, water pollution, biodiversity loss, and energy.

The objective of the Tyler Prize for Environmental Achievement is to recognize outstanding contributions to:

- Protection, maintenance, improvement, or understanding of an ecological or an environmental condition,
- Discovery, development, or improvement of sustainable sources of energy,
- Understanding of, or improvements to planetary health, and global solutions.

The Tyler Prize is awarded to individuals and institutions from any part of the world working to deliver global impact for the environment. The work of nominees is expected to:

- Be based on strong science, including natural and/or social sciences,
- Address global inequalities and solutions,
- Demonstrate measurable and scalable impact(s) on policy and/or practice,
- Demonstrate engagement with younger generations.
