III. Info Session - DIGITAL-2026-BESTUSE-AWARENESS - Common Research Framework on Information Integrity

This online information session focuses on the Digital Europe Programme call for proposals "DIGITAL-2026-BESTUSE-AWARENESS – Common Research Framework for Situational Awareness on Information Integrity". The call for proposals for the Common Research Framework is a grant for financial support, funded under the Digital Europe Programme (DEP).

Implementing a key deliverable of the European Democracy Shield Communication of November 2025, this call for proposals seeks to establish the first iteration of the Common Research Framework on Information Integrity. Core aims of the action include:

- Bridging gaps and silos in existing research efforts, to foster collaboration across communities, disciplines and borders,
- Expanding research capabilities, including through a targeted distribution of funds,
- Securing or setting up necessary technological infrastructure, comprising both hardware and software capacities, needed for advanced research on information integrity,
- Facilitating knowledge-sharing on how to use the regulatory tools that are at the disposal of researchers interested in studying online ecosystems.

The call targets stakeholders from research institutions, civil society, fact-checking, technology providers, and other interested stakeholders. It will fund one proposal with 6 million euros with a 100% funding rate over 24 to 30 months. At least 60% of the grant must be re-distributed via financial support to third parties.

IV. 1st SIDNET Training School – Call for Trainees and Trainers

The SiDnet COST Action is pleased to announce its first Training School. This three-day program is specifically designed to address the objectives of Working Group 1 (WG1), focusing on how science diplomacy can foster globally accepted standards and governance for new technologies while balancing national sovereignty, dual-usage of technologies, and alignment.

The curriculum is designed to create a “knowledge baseline” and to equip researchers, stakeholders, and practitioners with the skills to navigate the complex intersection of science, technology, international relations, legal studies, and diplomacy.

Key Topics Include:

- The European Science Diplomacy Framework and the EU's strategic positioning in domains like artificial intelligence, space, and cybersecurity.
- Introduction to WG1's focus: technology governance, ethics, and multi-stakeholder approaches.
- Outer Space Governance: Exploring the intersection of private sector control, dual-use technology, and outdated legal regimes.
- Neurotech & Cognitive Warfare: Evaluating the impact of brain-computer interfaces and neurotechnology on security and human rights.
- Multilateral Rule-Making: Addressing the lack of international capacity to agree and the risk of fragmented bilateral agreements.

Those who are interested may apply as Trainees or Trainers. Each category has its own description including target audience, eligibility and financial support. Please read it before applying.

V. Towards a competence framework for knowledge valorisation intermediaries

Join this interactive workshop to contribute to mapping intermediaries and discuss good practices, challenges and opportunities related to their roles, activities, competencies, and skills.

Knowledge valorisation intermediaries play a vital role in the innovation journey, bridging research results with market, policy or society uptake. They facilitate interactions among various R&I actors, help translating the needs and opportunities between supply and demand of innovation, and support the concrete implementation of solutions. These organisations come in various forms and take on different roles and activities. They include knowledge and technology transfer professionals, incubators, science parks, Union, national and regional innovation hubs or clusters, IP experts, consultants and innovation support professionals, science communication and policy engagement teams, knowledge for policy/science advice organisations and citizen engagement professionals, as mentioned in the Guiding principles for knowledge valorisation.

Given their important role in the research and innovation ecosystem throughout Europe, the ERA Policy Agenda 2025–2027 includes an initiative to build the capacity of intermediaries to strengthen links between academia, industry and public authorities by developing a competence framework for intermediaries.

To further support intermediaries, this workshop aims to map their roles, activities and competencies. This mapping will provide a basis for developing customisable framework of competencies at organisational level across the European Research Area.

VIII. Science Communication and Journalism: Call Opens for the Erice School

The call for the 2026 edition of the Erice International School of Science Communication and journalism is now open. The school awards 20 scholarships for young science journalists and communicators, 15 are reserved for applicants living in an EU country and 5 for foreign students living outside the EU. The 2026 edition's theme is "ENERGY FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE"

The Erice International School of Science Communication and journalism is a INFN short school held yearly at the Ettore Majorana Foundation and Centre for Scientific Culture, in Erice (Sicily), in Italy. The school is organised by the Italian National Institute for Nuclear Physics – INFN in collaboration with Springer Nature. It is dedicated to young science journalists and communicators from all over Europe and beyond. The program is based on lectures, practical

sessions, and other activities, dedicated to a different scientific theme each year, and held by researchers, science journalist and communication experts.

The school offers 15 scholarships for applicants living in an EU country (fee of the school, stay fully covered and economy class flight to Italy covered up to 500 euro+ transfer from Palermo airport only) and 5 scholarships for applicants from non-Eu (stay fully covered / trip at their own expenses).

The school is taking place from October 11th until October 13th in Erice, in Sicily (Italy). Accommodations are available from October 10th until October 14th; the program starts on the morning of October 11th (Sunday).

IX. Horizon Europe - Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Doctoral Networks 2026 - Call info day

During this event, the MSCA Doctoral Networks 2026 call will be presented in detail. This will provide prospective applicants and stakeholders with comprehensive guidance on the key requirements and novelties of the 2026 call, with particular emphasis on the Industrial and Joint Doctorate modes.

The event will also introduce the RAISE Doctoral Networks for AI in Science call, a new pilot initiative under Horizon Europe Cluster 4. This initiative builds on the MSCA Doctoral Networks 2026 call and offers additional funding opportunities for projects integrating artificial intelligence in scientific research, as well as for those developing advanced AI tools, systems and methodologies.

Participants will be invited to submit their questions via Slido, from the opening of the call on 28 May 2026 until the closing of the live Q&A session.

The online event will open with a welcome address and introductory remarks, followed by detailed presentations of the MSCA DN 2026 and RAISE DN 2026 calls, and will conclude with a live Q&A session.
